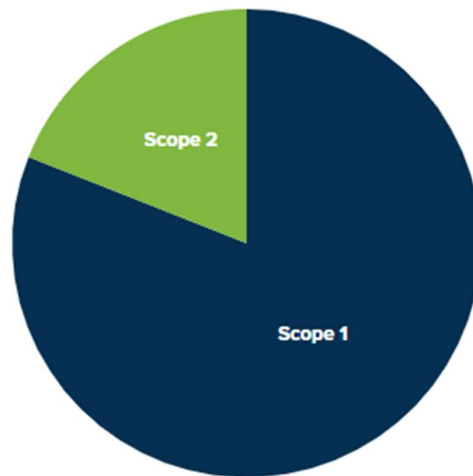


Sustainability Report

We have re-calculated our organisational carbon footprint using the Greenhouse Gas Protocol using Scopes 1 and 2 as we did last year, looking at our consumption of Electricity, Gas, Diesel and Petrol across all our depots.

The Company continues to advance its environmental initiatives by working with franchise partners to calculate its full carbon footprint, including Scope 3 emissions across the value chain. We actively monitor our impact and have expanded our low-emission fleet to include 14 fully electric company cars, an increasing number of PHEVs, 11 fully electric vans—4 of which support customer deliveries—and a newly added all-electric DAF truck in our demo fleet. These efforts contribute to measurable CO₂ reductions. While utility costs remain a challenge, we have secured fixed-rate agreements where possible to support cost stability and long-term sustainability planning.

We have also been looking at introducing solar panels across some of our sites to reduce the environmental impact further.

Scope 1: Direct emissions that result from activities within our company's control. This might include on-site fuel combustion, process emissions and company vehicles.

Scope 2: Indirect emissions from any electricity, heat or steam that we purchase and use. Although we are not directly in control of the emissions, by using the energy we are indirectly responsible for the release of CO₂.
